The gift of the Eucharist is available to those who previously had to drive long distances to go to Mass. The sacraments are celebrated, and religious formation is underway.

For families struggling to meet the daily necessities of food, clothing, and shelter, Missioners are present with compassionate, practical assistance in a manner that reaffirms their dignity. Glenmary mission parishes are often the only option for people with nowhere else to turn when in distress. Missioners also work for Christian unity in their communities, and nationwide, through dialogue and cooperation.

Together we are sharing hope through God's love and mercy!

In the last year, Glenmary rejoiced at the ordination of Father Cavine Okello and Father Joseph Maundu, both of whom are now serving growing home mission communities. They also, like so many of their brother Missioners,

are welcoming faith seekers to OCIA classes, taking the Eucharist to workers in farm fields and other remote rural locations, and guiding young parishioners through First Communion and Confirmation preparation. Across the missions, students receive tutoring, encouragement, and back to school supplies. Vacation Bible School is available in the summer. Presents and food for a holiday meal are distributed at Christmas. When flooding devastated Unicoi County, Tennessee, Glenmary's St. Michael the Archangel mission became a lifeline – a beacon of hope – for their community.






